CONTAINERS FOR CHANGE

WA's containers for change recycling scheme kicks off on the 1st October 2020. Eligible containers can be exchanged for 10c each, and using code **C10270759** to nominate the Beaconsfield P&C, donated towards various fundraising initiatives.

We will be discussing the potential to have recycling bins on school grounds for your convenience (next to Frank's gardening shed) at the P&C meeting. Alternatively, our closest recycling depots (where you can bag drop and nominate the P&C) are:

- Fremantle Recycling Centre, 81 Knutsford St, Fremantle
- City of Fremantle, 70 Parry St, Fremantle
- WA Container Exchange, 29 Bowen St, O'Connor OR Lucius Rd, Hamilton Hill

The scheme targets containers most often seen as litter. You can get 10c for any of the below containers. Check container labels to ensure you cash in on every eligible container and head to containersforchange.com.au/wa for more details.
