COVID Update	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - All year levels had reduced numbers from Week 7 Term 1 - Staff provided work for venerable students/families - School developed Home Learning Guidelines in consultation with staff, distributed to families via Connect - Term 2 return: school spent \$23,000+ on casual staff as part of the online team to allow classroom teachers to teach as close to normal as possible. Classes started week 1 with ~65%, quickly grew to 85/90%. - Awaiting Sem 1 reporting requirements from DoE
