We need to start future proofing our P&C, as there will be some changes in the next 18 months. I will be stepping down as President in October 2021, due to heading on a family adventure for all of 2022; our long-standing Secretary (Ruhi Bassari) has recently joined our School Board. With years of active participation from all our title bearers, we need to be planning to transition key roles of Beacy P&C to other committed members of our community.

The opportunities that the P&C provided for our children in the last 12 months have been so beneficial, with highlights including:

It is through the efforts of our committed P&C team that we have been able to enhance our children's school life and our school community. I have been so fortunate to lead such an incredible team of active P&C parents and community members over the last 18 months. I am sure new attendees would find that our meetings provide a welcoming environment where community members can learn about, and contribute positively, to our children's primary school lives. CURRENT P&C PROJECT UPDATES

Lapathon Update: Using the hard-run funds we have so far planted seven Tuarts and an additional three Coral Gums will be planted in September. Senior students will also be planting native tube-stocks later this term. Remaining funds will be used in 2022 (prior to winter rainfall) for all students to help with installing additional native cover and trees around the school. Yay for more plants and trees!

Sustainability Update: Pre-primaries participated in filling and planting out their own vege-gardens this week. It was wonderful to see all their happy and fulfilled faces. Big thanks to Shannon, Josh, Louise, Tash, Ms S and all the PP staff for helping get this initiative up and running. Containers for Change donations also continue to roll in. Playground Update: Our design has been classified as safe under all the required standards (yippee). However, due to a COVID construction boom, the costs are likely to rise (arghh – fundraise fundraise!) and the start date will lag...but it is still coming! Yay!!
