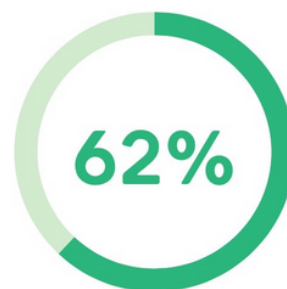
RECYCLE 4 RECESS
